First Aid Training

The Council have successfully applied for funding from Torridge District Council to enable a First Aid Training Course to be run in the Moore-Stevens Hall. The date for the training will be Friday 12th May 2017, and those who expressed an interest in attending will be notified of their course place shortly. Defibrillator

The Council has received a number of requests asking for a defibrillator to be made available within the Parish. The Council expects to receive the next instalment of the Alscott Farm Community Benefit Fund shortly, and at their meeting on 29th March 2017, they decided that once the money had arrived, it would be used to buy a defibrillator which will be housed in a lockable cabinet on the wall of the Moore-Stevens Hall. It is intended that the necessary PIN to open the cabinet will be held centrally so that someone phoning for an ambulance will be given that information, in appropriate cases. Further details will follow.

Devon CC Mobile Library

The number of people using the mobile library is under constant review, and some places lost their visit at the beginning of the year. 
